Designed for Health and Food Inspectors (municipal and state) charged with enforcement of the Massachusetts' Sanitary Codes 105 CMR 590 AND 1999 Federal Model Food Code

- **Level One Training Program encompasses:**
 - Pre-requisite coursework
 - Four days of classroom training
 - Graded final assessment (Worksheet)
- **Level Two adds:**
 - Joint field training
 - Online final assessment
- **Level Three adds:**
 - Online coursework (ORAU)
- **Level Four is standardization**

# Joint Inspections* (minimum)	Experience	Type of Food Establishments
Five	Participant has at least 3 years of regulatory food inspection experience or Participant has completed 100 independent regulatory food inspections	high risk
Two	Participant has less than 3 years of regulatory food inspection experience or Participant has not completed 100 independent regulatory food inspections	high risk with at least one low and one medium risk
