UNDERSTANDING MOVES IN TEAMWORK

There are four moves you can make in teamwork.

These moves can be played at different times by different people.

Initiate: → start action, propose new ideas

Follow: → accept the idea or proposal for action and support it actively

Oppose: → question the direction

Observe: → watch what is going on
